Mobility Scholarship at University of Turin (Italy) in the framework of the European

Programme ERASMUS+ KA171

Erasmus+ programme KA171 is a project aiming at fostering cooperation in the field of Higher Education between University of Turin (Italy) and Tunisian Institute of Agricultural Research of Tunisia (INRAT). The programme-mobility offers the possibility to spend a period of training at University of Turin (<https://en.unito.it/>) for Two PhD Students from the National Institute of Agronomy Tunisia.

In order to apply for a grant within the framework of Erasmus + KA171, candidates must comply with the following general requirements:

- Students must be registered in the National Institute of Agronomy Tunisia and and enrolled in Doctoral studies,
- Students must have sufficient knowledge of the English language.

By respecting gender balance, priority will be given to students:

- with disabilities,
- from under-privileged social and economic backgrounds.
- students must have a documented experience in research in livestock genetic field

Duration of the mobilities: 12 months

Fields of studies and training: Animal Genetics and Genomics (code 0811).

Amount of grants

- The Erasmus+ for study scholarships are contributions to support living costs in the hosting country. The scholarship for Italy is 900 € per month.
- Students will receive an additional amount of 309 € to cover the cost of travel.

Beneficiaries are responsible for:

- Contracting their travel arrangements.
- Visa expenses.
- Contracting insurance cover.

- Proof of pre-registration in the National Institute of Agronomy
- Research proposal
- Learning Agreement


